### SFP114S Take action to deal with environmental emergencies in a food environment

#### Unit Summary

### Key Words

<b>Environment</b>	Land, water and air
<b>Environmental emergency</b>	An emergency that occurs within an organisation that has the potential of having a negative impact on the environment.
<b>Tools and equipment</b>	Those used to contain and control substances that may have a negative impact on the environment. Eg. Spill kits
<b>Operating problems</b>	These could include problems with materials, tools or equipment.
