Unit Summary

This unit is about understanding the skills required by those who identify environmental legal requirements and other non-regulatory environmental requirements – such as those relating the sector of the organisation, customer requirements or those specific to the organisation.

You need to know and understand:

1. The key internal and external interested parties relevant to the organisation
2. How to engage interested parties in the process of identifying environmental legal and other non-regulatory environmental requirements
3. How to access sources of additional information and expertise
4. Relevant environmental legal and other non-regulatory environmental requirements applicable to the organisation
5. Key environmental regulators associated with environmental legislation
6. Consequences associated with breaching environmental legislation
7. The requirements for legal environmental documentation relevant to the organisation (which could include: discharge consents, process licences, permits and authorisation documents, waste documentation including transfer notes, site waste management plans, hazardous waste consignment notes)
8. Other environmental requirements applicable to the sector and the organisation (which could include: organisational, corporate and organisational-imposed requirements, industrial codes of practice, client/customer contractual agreements or requirements)
9. Reasons for evaluating compliance with environmental legal and other non-regulatory environmental requirements of the organisation
10. Different methods available for evaluating compliance with environmental legal and other non-regulatory environmental requirements of the organisation
11. How to identify and involve interested parties in the process of evaluating compliance with environmental legal and other non-regulatory environmental requirements
12. The purpose and use of control mechanisms
13. The process for identification and implementation of corrective, preventative or improvement actions
14. Methods for communicating the outcome of evaluation of compliance with environmental, legal and other non-regulatory environmental requirements
